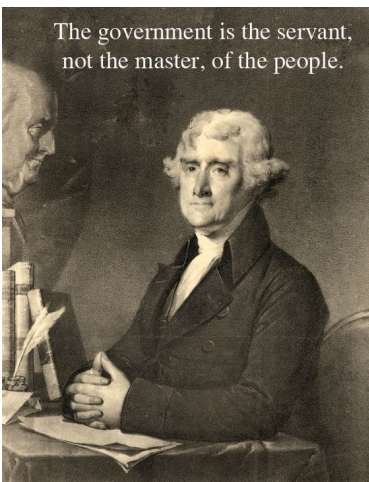


Local Politics Matter
